
On-line Sign-up and Scoring

Setup

1. Visit the web site: **netlore.com/ccl**
2. Use the **Login** button to register
 - a. Use your email address
 - b. Click the **New User** button when you get the unknown user message
3. Use the **top button** (labeled with the first part of your email) to enter your name and phone
 - a. Use a single last name (ex: Doe)
 - b. Enter everything else in the as the first name (ex: John & Jane, or John & Jane Smith)
 - c. Enter your 9 digit phone number
4. The top left icon is the home button for the app, use it to get the main screen
5. Save the main page so you can easily access it using one of the following methods
 - a. Safari: Use the Share button at the bottom and select save to home screen
 - b. Chrome: Use the  button at the top right and select save to home screen

Weekly Sign-up

1. Use the **Event Signup** button on the main page
